Rules of shooting: GNAS rules of shooting will apply, incorporating rule 304(f) Method 2.

Archers will shoot ends of six arrows in timed ends controlled in the following manner:-

- a. Two audible signals for archers in the first detail to take their positions on the shooting line.
- b. After 20 seconds one audible signal for shooting to commence.
- c. After 4 minutes, or earlier if shooting line is clear, 2 audible signals indicate that the archers remaining on the shooting line shall retire and the next detail take their place.
- d. After 20 seconds one audible signal for the second detail to commence shooting.
- e. And so continue until all details have shot when 3 audible signals shall indicate that archers are to move forward to score and collect arrows.
- f. An arrow shot before or after the allotted time will be considered as part of that end and will cause the archer to lose the highest scoring arrow of that end which will be scored as a miss.
- g. The time allowed for an archer to shoot each make-up arrow shall be 40seconds

All competitors must be affiliated to GNAS and cards may be inspected on the day.

Drug Testing: All record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Juniors must provide parental consent on the entry form and those under 16 be accompanied by a parent or guardian for the day.

Disclaimer: Devizes Bowmen or Devizes Sports Club will not accept liability for any loss, damage or injury incurred whilst on the premises. All missing arrows must be reported and found on the day.

Photography: As required by the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy anyone wishing to take photographs/filming at this shoot must first register with the tournament organiser.

Target list and Results Sheet: If required please enclose 2 large SAE's or provide e-mail address.

Medals: Medals will be awarded to winners in each category. Runners up medals will be awarded where 4 or more archers compete.

Third place medals will be presented where 7 or more archers participate. Please avoid changing your category on the day.
