



# Osprey Triple



Date 18<sup>th</sup> April 2010      Assembly 10:00 am      Cost of entry £10.00 per archer  
Venue; Nottingham Lane, between Tatton and Buckland Rippers,

From the west, travel from Portesham along the B3157. Turn left at “BLIND SUMMIT” signs. Continue for 1 mile looking for overhead power lines. Entrance on the right.

From the east: from Dorchester Road A354, look for school signs and pelican crossing, (only signed NOTTINGHAM if heading towards Weymouth) and turn into NOTTINGTON LANE. In Nottingham at the “ABBOTSBURY 7” sign, bear right. After 1.6 miles look for overhead power lines entrance on left.

Rounds to be completed: Single one-way Clout (distance according to age group). Field 12 Target Woodsman Round. Target consisting of 3 dozen arrows, 122cm face, ten zone scoring, Adults 70 metres, Juniors 50 metres. Order of rounds subject to group allocation. No sighters will be shot.

Group 1: Clout, Field, Target.      Group 2: Target, Clout, Field.      Group 3: Field, Target, Clout.

Bow Styles: Compound, Recurve and Longbows. No changing of style during the tournament. Medals awarded subject to entry.

## Shooting Rules.

- (i) Three shots are permitted at each target, one from each of three posts, each successive post being closer to the target than the previous one.
- (ii) The archer shall stop shooting as soon as a kill is considered to have been made.
- (iii) Juniors under 18 shoot from the same post as adults in all cases.
- (iv) Juniors under 15 shoot up to two arrows from the middle distance post and up to one from the front post until a kill is scored.
- (v) Juniors under 12 shoot up to three arrows from the front post until a kill is scored.

## Scoring:

1st arrow kill 30, 2nd arrow kill 20, 3rd arrow kill 10.

1st arrow wound 5, 2nd arrow wound 5, 3rd arrow wound 5.

Example scores would be:

1st arrow wound (5) + 2nd arrow kill (20) + 3rd arrow not shot = total 25 points.

1st arrow wound (5) + 2nd arrow wound (5) + 3rd arrow kill (10) = total 20 points.

On score cards show the total score.
