

Grants Policy Document - 2015

The County supports the objective of promoting and encouraging the pursuit of archery within the County and Region and will consider any application for a grant fairly and on a case-by-case basis.

The County may provide sponsorship grants to its members who are requested by the appropriate governing bodies to represent England or Great Britain at international competitions at senior and junior levels. The grant is to cover the applicant's out of pocket expenses only. The purchase of equipment is not included.

The criteria for an archer to be eligible to receive a grant are as follows:-

- 1. The archer has to incur extra expense to participate, which is not being covered by the requesting governing body.
- 2. The archer must provide a copy of your invitation to compete by the appropriate governing body.
- 3. The archer must declare all sponsorship, in value and kind, and funding they are currently receiving.
- 4. The applicant must write to the County Secretary requesting a grant alone with a completed grant application form (see website) giving their name, ArcheryGB membership number, address and to whom the grant should be paid.
- 5. When requested, receipts of purchases must be provided as proof of any necessary expense.
- 6. The archer must be a paid up member of County and Region.

The allocation of grants in any one year will be reviewed from time to time by the committee.
