General Information

Equipment inspection shall startd at 8:30am and practice will commence at 9:15am. The first round will then commence after practice is complete. There will be a break for lunch between rounds. Practice times will be at the discretion of the judge.

Refereshments

Food and drink will be available to purchase all day including burgers and bacon rolls, a selection of cake, and tea, coffee and soft drinks

Available Rounds

Rounds available to shoot are:

- WA 70m - Senior Gents and Ladies
- WA 60m - Cadet Round Senior Under 21, Junior Under 18
- WA 50m (80cm 6 zone face) - Compound
- Metric 122-50 - Junior Under 16
- Metric 122-40 - Junior Under 14 Boys
- Metric 122-30 - Junior Under 12 Boys

Archers can shoot up or down a distance but may not be eligible for any awards or records. No crossbows round will be shot. Compound targets may be setup wth 4 targets to a boss where arechers shoot one round at an upper face and the other round at a lower face.

Awards

- First place medal where a minimum of 1 archer is shooting in a class.
- Second place medal where a minimum of 4 archers is shooting in a class.
- Third place medal where a minimum of 7 archers is shooting in a class.
- Trophies to be decided on day of shoot.

Rules of Shooting

The Archery GB Rules of Shooting shall apply. Scoring will be in accordance with Archery GB rule 306, and dress regulation rule 307 shall apply.

All participating archers may be liable for drug testing, and entries from archers under 18 must be acknowledged by a parent/guardian to signify consent.

Juniors must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.

Timed ends of 6 arrows at a time will be shot.

Special Requirements

If you have any special requirements please let the tournament organiser know when applying.

Photography

In view of the Archer GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anyone who wishes to take photographs of the event must register with the Tournament Organiser.
