Drug Testing	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drug testing.  Competitors who are approached to provide samples must comply.  Failure to do so will be treated as a positive result.  Parents/Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form to give consent for under 18s to be drug tested if approached	
Refreshments	Catering will be available throughout the Championships	
Photography	Anyone wishing to take photos or video at the event must sign the register first	
Car Parking	Please park in the gravel car park. Only those camping on site and registered disabled are permitted to take vehicles onto the field.	
Camping	Camping is available for tents & caravans from Friday to Monday Access NOT before Noon on Friday - Departure by Noon on Tuesday	
Lost Arrows	The venue is a playing field and all arrows <b>MUST</b> be accounted for. All lost arrows must be reported to a judge. It is the archer's responsibility to locate any missed arrows before leaving the field. If you intend to shoot all carbon arrows, you must indicate on the entry form how you intend to find them should you miss the target.
