Event Format	All bosses will be TenZone layered foam bosses 4 archers per boss for all rounds All shooting will be in timed ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes, in 2 details 70m & 60m will shoot on 122cm/80cm faces, 50m on 6 zone 80cm faces
Trophies	In an effort to recover as many as possible of the "missing" DWAA trophies from this and other County tournaments; trophies will not be awarded at this tournament this year; just medals as below, subject to the DWAA Medal Policy
Medals	In all classes County & Visitor (subject to entries) Masters Recurve Awards: Over age 50 in 2017 shooting the 60m round Junior Recurve Awards: Up to age 20 in 2017 shooting the 70m round Cadet Recurve Awards: Up to age 17 in 2017 shooting the 60m round Junior Compound Awards: Up to age 20 in 2017 shooting the 50m round Cadet Compound Awards: Up to age 17 in 2017 shooting the 50m round
Dress	All competitors must comply with Archery GB dress regulations (see rule 307) Any archer not complying with these regulations will not be permitted to shoot. See Archery GB Rules of Shooting Rule 307 for details
Drug Testing	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to provide samples must comply. Failure to do so will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form to give consent for under 18s to be drug tested if approached
Refreshments	Refreshments will be available throughout the day from the South Wilts AC tent
Photography	Anyone wishing to take photos or video at the event must sign the register first
Car Parking	Please park in the designated bays of the school car parks. Do not park on the grass or obstruct any gateways
