

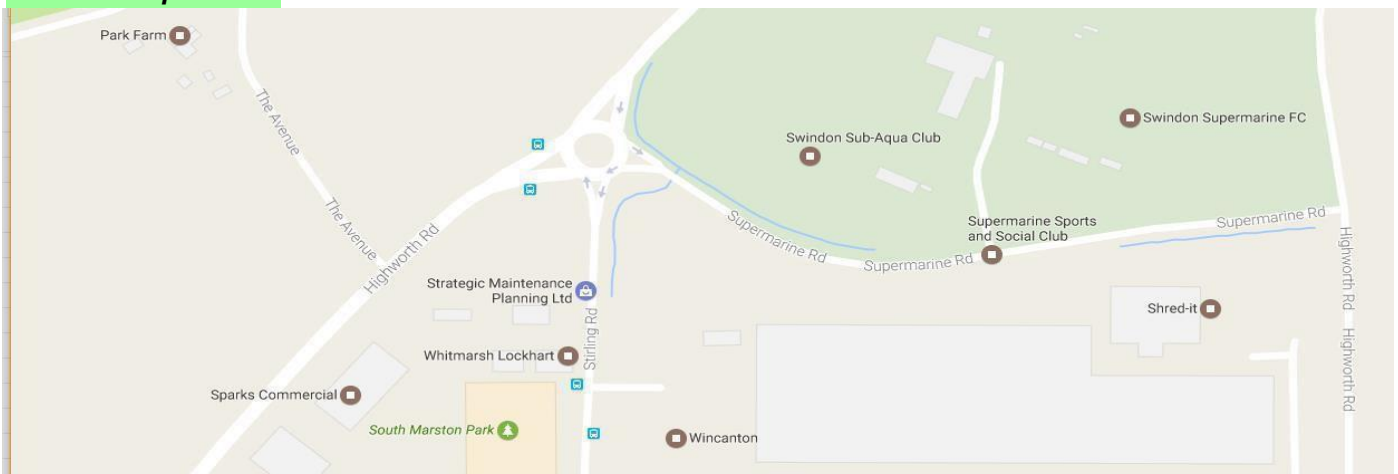

<b>Event Format</b>	All bosses will be Tenzon layered foam on 4 legs There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details on full size faces at both longer distances. Reduced faces for the two shorter distances Ends of 6 arrows all day to be shot in timed ends of 4 minutes. Longbow & Barebow will shoot full size faces all day
<b>Rounds Awards Medals Teams</b>	Ladies and Gentlemen WA 1440 Junior Gentlemen under 18 METRIC I Junior Gentlemen under 16, Junior Ladies under 18 METRIC II Junior Gentlemen under 14, Junior Ladies under 16 METRIC III Junior Gentlemen under 12, Junior Ladies under 14 METRIC IV Junior Ladies under 12 METRIC V DWAA GENERAL MEDAL POLICY (unless otherwise stated) Number of competing archers per group and awards provided at this shoot:  RECURVE TEAM of 4 archers must include 1 lady or gent, and 3 must be seniors. MIXED TEAM of 4 (2 recurve & 2 compound) must include 1 lady or gent, and 3 must be seniors.
<b>Dress</b>	All competitors must comply with Archery GB dress regulations (see rule 307) <b>Any archer not complying with these regulations will not be permitted to shoot.</b> See Archery GB Rules of Shooting Rule 307 for details
<b>Drug Testing</b>	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to provide samples must comply. Failure to do so will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form to give consent for under 18s to be drug tested if approached
<b>Refreshments</b>	Refreshments will be available throughout the day from the Supermarine catering tent

<b>Photography</b>	Anyone wishing to take photos or video at the event must sign the register first
<b>Car Parking</b>	Please park in Supermarine's lower field. Do not park on the grass on the shooting field or obstruct any gateways or pathways in the sports centre
<b>Lost Arrows</b>	The venue is a sports playing field and all arrows <b>MUST</b> be accounted for. All lost arrows must be reported to a judge. It is the archer's responsibility to locate any missed arrows before leaving the field. <b>If you intend to shoot all carbon arrows, you must indicate with your entry how <u>you</u> intend to find them should you miss the target.</b>
<b>Dogs</b>	No dogs are permitted on the premises.
<b>Smoking</b>	<b>Smoking: If you need to smoke, please do so in the clear area behind the catering tent.</b> This includes E-cigarettes
