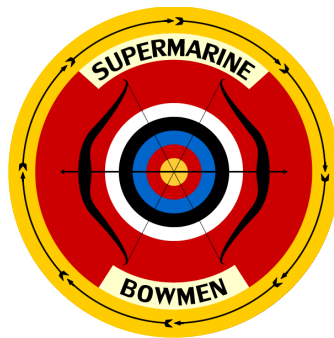

Entries from archers under 18 must be signed by a parent/ guardian to signify their consent to
their child being drug tested if approached.
