Things to note!	 Archery GB Rules of Shooting, including Rule 307 Dress Regulations, will apply. Competitors must be affiliated to Archery GB & have their cards available for checking. The targets will be straw bosses on H stands, with double bosses for compound bows. Bath Archers will not be held responsible for injury to any person, whether competitor or spectator, or for loss or damage to equipment. Archery GB cover only will apply – entry implies acceptance of these conditions. Anyone wishing to take photographs/video must complete the Photograph Log before doing so. Entries for junior archers must be signed by a parent or guardian. The Field Captain is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times. His/her decision in all matters is final and must be obeyed. The organiser has the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour. Bacon butties will be available prior to the start and at lunchtime, and hot & cold drinks and home-made cakes will be available during the day. For the comfort of all archers and spectators Bath Archers operates a 'No Smoking' policy, except in a designated area.

Follow A46 from M4 Junction 18 towards Bath.

When you reach the large underpass on the dual-carriageway, take the left hand lane up to the roundabout.

At the roundabout turn left towards Batheaston.

From the South

On the A36 follow the route through Bathampton, over the narrow Canal Bridge. and proceed over the Toll Bridge over the river Avon (80p toll).

Up the hill turn left at the mini roundabout;
