


Directions to Green Lane Playing Fields, Devizes, Wiltshire SN10 5DS

From Devizes town centre, at the Roses roundabout, take the A342 Nursteed Road (Signposted to Andover) and at the second roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Marshall Road.

From Swindon/North. Approaching Devizes on A361, cross roundabout at B&Q, pass the Esso garage on your right and take the 3rd exit on the next roundabout onto Windsor Drive, cross first two roundabouts and take the 1st exit on the third roundabout heading towards Andover on A342. Immediately take the 3rd exit on the next roundabout onto Marshall Road.

Drive past the Green Lane hospital on your left and at the roundabout take the 1st exit onto Green Lane. Follow the road and carry straight on at the right hand bend. The entrance to the car park is immediately on your left.

Rose Awards: Archers shooting the York, Hereford and Bristol rounds can now claim Rose Awards at the Devizes Top Ten. Please claim on the day of the Tournament as no claims will be accepted once the event is completed.

Rules of shooting: Archery GB Rules of Shooting will apply, incorporating Rule 304(f) Method 2. Archers will shoot ends of six arrows in timed ends of four minutes. All competitors must be affiliated to Archery GB and cards may be inspected on the day.

Dress regulation 307 applies. Any archer not dressed in accordance with Archery GB Rule 307 will not be allowed to shoot. Please ensure you are fully aware of this rule by consulting the Archery GB Rules of Shooting to avoid any disappointment or embarrassment.

Timing Lights: Shooting will be under the control of the Judges using countdown timing lights, indicating the detail shooting as well as a traffic light display in accordance with Archery GB Rule 304 f (ii) Method 2 **Banned Substance Testing:** All UK record status shoots will be liable for banned substance testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. **Juniors** must provide parental consent on the entry form and those under 16 be accompanied by a parent or quardian for the day.

Equipment Inspection: As now required by Archery GB, equipment inspection is mandatory at all UK record status shoots. Please ensure your equipment fully complies with the rules of shooting and present it for inspection on the day. Failure to do so will disqualify you from shooting.

Disclaimer: Devizes Bowmen or Devizes Town Council will not accept liability for any loss, damage or injury incurred whilst on the premises. All missing arrows must be reported and found on the day. The venue is a Sports Field so we would prefer no "all carbon" arrows are used. If you do intend to shoot "all carbon" arrows then please state clearly on the entry form. Archers will be responsible for ensuring any lost arrows are found before leaving the venue.

Food & Drink: Tea and coffee will be available all day. Bacon and sausage baps served before the shoot, with barbeque lunch and homemade cakes available to purchase.

Smoking or Vaping: Will only be allowed behind the Tent Line.

Photography: As required by the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy anyone wishing to take photographs/filming at this shoot must first register with the tournament organiser.

Target lists and Results Sheet: If required please enclose 2 large SAE's **or** provide your e-mail address. Target Lists and results will be posted on Devizes Bowmen and DWAA Web site.

GDPR: When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.

The Tournament Organiser is required to share such data with Archery GB as part of the Record Status Tournament Report, however if you do not consent to this information being shared with Archery GB, other entrants and Tournament officials & Judges, please state clearly on the entry form.

Medals: Medals will be awarded to winners in each category. Runners up medals will be awarded where 4 or more archers compete in a category. Third place medals will be presented where 7 or more archers participate in a category.

An archer may only represent the club through which they are affiliated. It is requested that Team Captains submit their team scores as soon as possible after shooting is completed, using the forms provided.
