Event Format	All bosses will be Tenzone layered foam on 4 legs There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details on full size faces at both longer distances. Reduced faces for the two shorter distances Ends of 6 arrows all day to be shot in timed ends of 4 minutes. Longbow & Barebow will shoot full size faces all day
Rounds Awards Medals Teams	Ladies and Gentlemen WA 1440 Junior Gentlemen under 18 METRIC I Junior Gentlemen under 16, Junior Ladies under 18 METRIC II Junior Gentlemen under 14, Junior Ladies under 16 METRIC III Junior Gentlemen under 12, Junior Ladies under 14 METRIC IV Junior Ladies under 12 METRIC V Medals will be awarded according to entries. RECURVE TEAM of 4 archers from one club to include at least 1 lady or 1 gent, and at least 3 must be seniors. MIXED TEAM of 4 from one club (2 recurve & 2 compound) to include at least 1 lady or 1 gent, and at least 3 must be seniors.
Dress	All competitors must comply with Archery GB dress regulations (see rule 307) Any archer not complying with these regulations will not be permitted to shoot.
Drug Testing	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to provide samples must comply. Failure to do so will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form to give consent for under 18s to be drug tested if approached.
Refreshments	Refreshments will be available throughout the day from the South Wilts AC tent.
Photography	Anyone wishing to take photos or video at the event must sign the register first.
Car Parking	Please park in the designated bays of the school car parks. Do not park on the grass or obstruct any gateways.
Lost Arrows	The venue is a school playing field and all arrows MUST be accounted for. All lost arrows must be reported to a judge. It is the archer's responsibility to locate any missed arrows before leaving the field. If you intend to shoot all carbon arrows, you must indicate with your entry how you intend to find them should you miss the target.

Dogs	No dogs are permitted on the school premises.
Smoking	Smoking is not permitted on the school premises. If you need to smoke, please do so OUTSIDE the school gates. This includes E-cigarettes
