
Purbeck Sports Centre: Worgret Rd, Wareham **BH20 4PH**

There is no camping available at this field. There are plenty of camping venues available in the surrounding area.



RULES

This tournament will be run in accordance with the Archery GB rules of Shooting at the time of the competition.

Awards in all sections subject to entry.

There will be Awards for **Veterans** shooting the York & Hereford (If you are willing to own up to being over 50!).

Novices There will be an award for the highest scoring novice archer (in their first year of archery) shooting the National round (please indicate on entry form).

Victor Ludorum Junior will be based of the following – Clout (based on age group) and Hereford (Junior Ladies) or York (Junior Gents)
Senior Lady & Gent will be based on the following, Highest placing in 3 events - Longbow, Clout & York or Hereford.

Team where team awards are available, the team captains should submit their clubs' score to the Tournament Organiser ASAP at the end of the shoot.

PHOTOGRAPHY: anyone wishing to take photographs of the event must register with the tournament organiser. Please note: Photographs may be used by DWAA for publicity purposes. If you DO NOT wish to be photographed please let the Tournament Organiser know.

Dress: Any archer not dressed in accordance with rule 307 will not be allowed to shoot. Please, ensure you are fully aware of this rule. See Archery GB rule 307.

Shooting: Longbow two way western will be shot in Straw bosses. York, Hereford and National will be shot on Tenzone. The Archery Shop have kindly Sponsored the Event.

Dogs: No Dogs are permitted on the Field, except assistance dogs

Food: Refreshments will be available from All Stars Sports Bar (located in the sports centre) it is recommended that you pre order food.
