SHOOTING	There will be three archers per boss shooting in a single detail 6 arrows per end in 4 mins for the two longer distances 3 arrows per end in 2 mins for 50m and 30m
TIMINGS	Equipment inspection from 09:00. Assembly at 09:30 which will be followed by 45 mins of practice.
ENTRY FEE	£17.00 - cheques payable to "Somerset County Archery Association".
CLOSING DATE	8th September 2019. As space is limited, early entry is advisable.
LATE ENTRY FEE	There will be a late entry fee of £3.00 per person
JUNIORS	Juniors may enter and will be eligible for awards but must shoot the appropriate senior round.
AWARDS	Awards for Ladies/Gents recurve/compound/longbow The "Battle of Britain" Barrel presented by RAFA for the highest score by a team of three recurves from a SCAA club. Medal for the 1st placed ex RAF lady or gentleman Compound team of three archers from one club - open 1007 Tankard - lady or gent with score nearest 1007 - open Other awards according to entries

DRUG TESTING	All archers will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or guardians must authorise drugs testing of junior archers on the entry form.
