Rounds: 1440 (90m) – Men under 21

Metric 1 or 1440 (70m) - Men under 18, Women under 21

Metric 2 – Men under 16, Women under 18 Metric 3 – Men under 15, Women under 16 or 15

Metric 4 – Men and Women under 14 Metric 5 – Men and Women under 12

Arrows will be shot in timed ends of 6. At the two shorter distances Longbow and Barebow will shoot

on a full size 80cm face. Recurve and Compound on individual 5-x 80cm faces

We will be shooting on foam targets and double scoring will be used (paper and PDAs)

Location: Cleve Archers grounds, Down Yonder, Old Bromley Heath Road, Hambrook, Bristol, BS16 6JA. Please

Entry Fee: £11.50 per Archer. Payment through the GWAS BookWhen entry form. Additionally each County to

pay £100 towards the tea and field hire. Please speak to the Organiser regarding that payment. Those Archers that expect to be part of the County Team will need to speak to their Team Manager to

claim their entry fee back.

Closing Date: Sunday 7th September, which is also the preferred date for team submissions.

Dress: Archery GB Dress code rule 307 will apply. If not appropriately dressed, you will not be able to shoot.

Photography: Cameras and photography equipment to be registered with the Tournament Organiser
